

LINE JUDGE

- Must be at least 16 years of age;
- Must wear white top and black skirt/pants
- 2 Line Judges are needed for individual routines - will be seated in chairs opposite each other at the corners of the competitive carpet – each Judge watches 2 lines (right and left)
- 4 Line Judges for Groups – will be seated in chairs at each corner of the competitive carpet – each Judge watches the line to his/her right
- If apparatus or gymnast cross the line on the floor, or the floor outside the line, then the Line Judge waves the red flag and records it on the tablet
- **Please, make sure all records are done AFTER the routine is over – you can miss another mistake**
- Line Judge must raise a flag for:
 1. The apparatus or body crossing the boundary of the floor area;
- Line Judge must raise TWO flags if:
 1. Both the apparatus and body cross the boundary of the floor area;
- Please make notes on Rotations of any deduction you have sent to scoring system.

NOTE: please, continue to watch the routine and input all mistakes on tablet as soon as the routine is finished. (If you put your head down to write, you may miss it if the gymnast goes out again). It is important to be accurate;

Raise the flag and mark the mistake **only if the apparatus or gymnast crosses the line or touches the floor outside the line**. If the gymnast or apparatus touch the line but does not cross the line or touch the floor outside the line – this is not an infraction and you don't record it or waive the flag.
